It is expected that not enough new colonies will be available to supply to members who already have bees, for those members wishing to expand their hives every assistance will be given in splitting their existing colonies

Swarms will continue to be collected by GBKA Committee members and will be kept at the Association apiary and used as a basis for raising colonies with viable young queens. Each colony will only be passed on when it has been established that it has a laying queen – which will be clipped and marked.

The charge for a colony will be £60, plus return of brand new frames for the ones you will be supplied with.
