Terms and Conditions

- Instruments are offered subject to availability.
- A refundable deposit of £100 is required at the time of booking. This deposit will be refunded in full once the instrument is returned. Tetractys Publishing reserves the right to deduct the cost of any necessary repairs from the deposit if required.
- The minimum fee is one week's hire, paid in advance. If the instrument is returned late, a further week's fees will be charged. For long term hires, the minimum fee is two month's hire, paid in advance.
- Extensions of the hire term may be arranged during the hire, with all fees due at the time of arrangement. For long term hires, payment can be made monthly by standing order.
- Instruments can be collected from Windsor or alto flutes only may be posted to the hirer at the hirer's cost and risk. Other collection/return arrangements may be made at the discretion of Tetractys Publishing.
- The hirer is liable for loss or any damage to the instrument during the hire period, including any damage sustained in transit and any loss or damage through circumstances outside of the hirer's control.
- The instruments will be sent out in full working order; please contact us with any problems and do not take the instrument to any repairers without receiving prior permission from Tetractys Publishing.
- Instruments must remain in the UK during the entire hire period.
- The hirer agrees to look after the instrument carefully and with common sense during the time of the hire.
- 2 forms of ID are required for the hire - a passport or driving license and a recent (within 2 months) utility bill or bank statement with full address details.
