- 8 Pot plant - house

### Section B / Floral Art

- 9 Arrangement of Summer flowers - overall size 50cm (20")
- 10 Miniature arrangement of flowers

### Section C / Vegetables and Produce / HENDERSON CUP

- 11 Beetroot - three, any variety with 3" tops
- 12 Broad Beans in a pod - three, any variety
- 13 Cabbage - one, any variety

- 23 Peas in a pod - six, any variety
- 24 Potatoes - three, any variety
- 25 Shallots - five, any variety, avoid excessive tops
- 26 Tomatoes - three, any variety
- 27 Turnips - three, any variety with 3" tops
- 28 Hens eggs - four, matching
- 29 Bowl of soft fruit - home grown display
- 30 Box of vegetables/salad any variety - grown by exhibitor and presented in a box maximum size 50cmx50cm (20"x20" approx)

- 78 A Cress Creature – cress growing in a recycled/ decorated container - max size 20cm x 10cm
- 79 Flowers or veg. growing in a pair of their old shoes or trainers

10 – 15YRS

- 80 Four carrots growing in a can or pot
  - 81 Flowers/ veg. growing in a welly boot.
- Classes 78-81 must be grown from seeds.

# SHOW RULES

- Exhibits must be from individuals (except Class 77).
- Exhibits in section A, B and C must have been grown by the exhibitor for at least two months.
- Sections H and I are open to boys and girls and must be their own work.
- All classes are open to non-residents of Assynt.
- Exhibits in section D, E and G must have been completed in the last twelve months.
- Every reasonable care will be taken to safeguard exhibits vases etc...  
But the organisers cannot be responsible for loss or damage.
- The Judge's decision is final.
