

BOOKING FEE

A non-refundable booking fee of 25% is required to secure the date. Dates are reserved only when the booking fee is paid. This sum will apply towards the contract fee.

TERMS

It is mutually agreed that the following terms and conditions form an integral part of this contract/invoice and that no variation or modification of this contract shall be effective unless accepted by Victoria Woolley Event Photography (also called "the Photographer") in writing.

PAYMENTS

The balance of the payment for the services contracted for must be paid for six weeks before the wedding date as stated in the booking form. Payment for additional photographs and albums is made when these are ordered. Any bank charges incurred due to returned cheques will be debited to the Client.

CANCELLATION

In the event of the Client cancelling a booking for wedding photography Victoria Woolley reserves the right to charge a cancellation fee in accordance with the following scale:

25%, (the booking fee), if cancelled more than 12 months prior to the wedding date.

100% of the agreed fee if cancelled within 7 days of the wedding date.

Should the cancelled wedding turn out to be a postponement, then subject to availability on a new date, monies other than the booking fee may be applied to the new wedding. In the event of Victoria Woolley having to cancel photographing the wedding, due to illness or accident, any fees paid, including the deposit, will be returned to the Client. In this instance Victoria Woolley will also do her utmost to provide an alternative photographer from her list of professional contacts.

WEATHER AND/OR DELAYS

Weather permitting, the photographs will be taken as agreed. In the event of inclement weather the photographer, in co-operation with the Client, will make the necessary changes to the schedule and will do her best to produce coverage of the wedding within the time allocated to her. Similarly, when delays occur due to circumstances outside her control, the photographer will stay on beyond the agreed time but may charge a small additional fee for extra time involved.

REQUESTED PHOTOGRAPHS

Victoria Woolley will honour requests for specific photographs subject to the following: weather and time permitting; availability and the co-operation of the person(s) concerned.

CO-OPERATION

All parties agree to provide as full a cooperation as is reasonable to ensure the best possible outcome of the day, both prior to and during the event. Family and friends are permitted to take photographs as long as they do not disturb, disrupt or interfere with the photographer's duties. The Photographer will not be held liable where such disruption results in their inability to fulfil their duties of this agreement.

COVERAGE

Victoria Woolley cannot be held responsible for the lack of coverage caused by the bride, bridegroom or other members of the wedding party not being ready on time, nor by restrictions placed on the photographer by officials of the church, register office or licensed marriage venues. Victoria Woolley does not guarantee any specific picture nor to include any specific background, location, props, or arrangement, although every effort will be made to interpret the Client's wishes. Victoria Woolley is limited by the guidelines of the ceremony official or reception site management. The Client agrees to accept the technical results of their imposition on the photographer. Negotiation with the officials for moderation of guidelines is the Client's responsibility.

WEDDING GUEST PHOTOGRAPHERS: All your guests will have digital cameras and all your guests will want to photograph the bride and groom. In the spirit of cheerful cooperation the bride and groom agree to give the photographer precedence over your guests in order to take the photographs required for the wedding services described above. We cannot be held liable for a lack of wedding photos if the photographers work has been continually interrupted by guests taking their own photos of the bride and groom.

HOUSE RULES: Note the photographer is sometimes limited by rules imposed by registrars, ministers and venue management as to what can and cannot be done. For example some ministers insist that no flash photography is allowed, and others will insist that the photographer shoot from a specific location. In such circumstances the bride and groom agree to accept the technical limitations that may be imposed on the equipment used. We advise the bride and groom to make themselves aware of the rules of the venue concerned and if necessary negotiate with the individuals concerned. Where possible, this will be identified by Victoria Woolley Event photography and communicated to the Bride and Groom prior to the wedding day.

COLOUR MATCHING and SIZES

Owing to photochromatic anomalies caused by a combination of certain dyes and materials, especially in man-made fibres, it is sometimes impossible to record on camera the exact colour of materials as perceived by the human eye. When processing images, Victoria Woolley will endeavour to achieve a pleasing overall colour balance based on natural flesh tones. It is understood that some colours may not remain consistent throughout a set of photographs owing to variations in lighting conditions. It is also understood that all photographic printing is undertaken within the technical limitations of the process and that colour may not be identical over the whole range within a subject. The colour balance of prints made at different times or in varying sizes may also be variable. Due to the limitations of computer monitors it is understood that images may appear differently according to the specification of each monitor and that prints will not match images rendered on any particular computer monitor.

COPYRIGHT

The copyright in all photographs created by Victoria Woolley shall remain her property in accordance with the Copyright, Design and Patents Act 1988. Victoria Woolley will supply a letter with the presentation USB stick of images to allow the client permission to print images through a third party. Victoria Woolley accepts no responsibility for the quality and colour reproduced from third party printers of images taken from Copyright free images supplied, due to variations in paper and third party printing processes and profiles. The Photographer retains all copyright and reserves the right to use images for the promotion of herself or her business without recourse or compensation to the client.

Original Files

All electronic images created by Victoria Woolley shall remain the property of Victoria Woolley who will undertake to store all such materials safely and make them available for future reproduction. Photographic prints will become and remain the property of the Client(s). However the Client(s) specifically acknowledge that ownership of prints does not imply ownership of the copyright in the images on them, or any right to reproduce, or authorise the reproduction of, such images.

DELIVERY TIMES

Presentation USB: USB will be delivered within 14 days from the wedding date (this may be longer in peak periods).

Albums: Where ordered, albums, depending on the style and size, will be delivered within 12 weeks from the wedding day.

Victoria Woolley will supply the album and number of pages that has been ordered subject to any variations that the Client may make. Any variations over and above that originally ordered by the Client will be charged at the rate current at the time of commission, and will be included in the final account.

MODEL RELEASE

The Client hereby grants to Victoria Woolley and its legal representatives and assigns, the irrevocable and unrestricted right to use and publish photographs of the Client or in which the Client may be included, for editorial, trade, advertising and any other purpose and in any manner and medium; to alter the same without restriction; and to copyright the same. The Client hereby releases Victoria Woolley and its legal representatives and assigns from all claims and liability relating to said photographs. Victoria Woolley will ask permission from the Client to publish a photograph, and the Client has the right to refuse publishing.
