

About our Club and the Next Generation

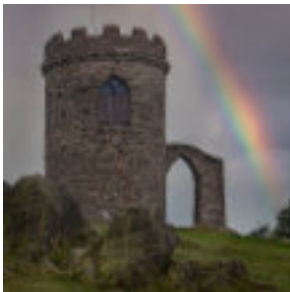
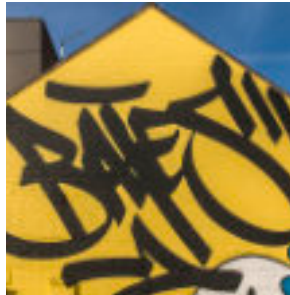
Leicester Forest Photographic Society was formed by a few ordinary, but special people with a keen interest in photography in 1965.

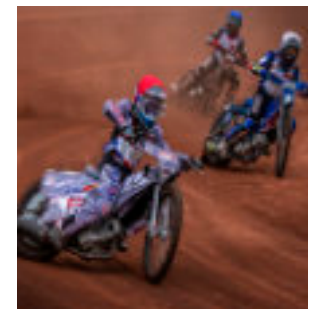
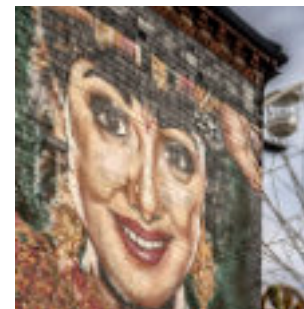


Leicester Forest Photographic Society, consists of a group of local photographers committed to promoting photography in all its forms to local communities.

Photowalks with other members to local events and venues.

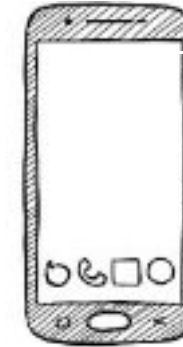
