The deposit is due on signing this agreement, with the balance due on or before the day of the wedding.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT: This agreement contains the entire understanding between Adrian Jackson trading as *Adrian Jackson Photography* and the Bride and Groom. It replaces any prior agreements that may have been made.

CONFIRMATION: A signed wedding contract and deposit are necessary to confirm the stated wedding services from *Adrian Jackson Photography*.

PRE-WEDDING CONSULTATION: This will normally happen at the time of booking. The bride and groom will outline broadly what is required and *Adrian Jackson Photography* will advise on planning, logistics and timings where needed. If required, the bride and groom are welcome to seek additional guidance closer to the time of the

wedding to iron out the remaining details. In any case we will contact you by phone a few days before the wedding to ensure that there have been no last minute changes. Where appropriate, *Adrian Jackson Photography* request permission to attend the wedding rehearsal to enable us to thoroughly prepare for the wedding day and consult with the Minister/Registrar to identify local restrictions i.e. use of confetti etc.

COOPERATION: The bride and groom and *Adrian Jackson Photography* consent to cheerfully cooperate and communicate with each other to achieve the best possible result within the understanding of this contract. We recommend that the wedding photographer is provided with a helper (usually the best man or an usher) who will point out key individuals to be photographed. The photographer may also require the assistance of the identified person for organising family groups. The bride and groom also agree to give the photographer sufficient warning of key events at the wedding to give the photographer time to prepare e.g. Bouquet throwing, cutting the cake, speeches etc. Please note that not all guests at wedding like having their photo taken. In such cases the wedding photographer will use his discretion but cannot be held responsible for a lack of photos of these people.

THE SCHEDULE : Our shooting schedule, style of working and experience are designed to achieve a perfect set of wedding photos for the bride and groom, accomplished with good humour and enjoyed by all concerned. Both the bride and groom and *Adrian Jackson Photography*, therefore, agree that punctuality and cheerful cooperation are essential to producing outstanding photographic results. In cases where the wedding does not run on time (for example, extreme lateness by the bride arriving to the church) we cannot guarantee to take our normal set of photos although in such circumstances we will do our absolute best to compensate.

WEDDING GUEST PHOTOGRAPHERS: All your guests will have digital cameras and all your guests will want to photograph the bride and groom. In the spirit of cheerful cooperation the bride and groom agree to give the photographer precedence over your guests in order to take the photographs required for the wedding services described above. We cannot be held liable for a lack of wedding photos if the photographers work has been continually interrupted by guests taking their own photos of the bride and groom.

HOUSE RULES/WEATHER: Note the photographer is sometimes limited by rules imposed by registrars, ministers and venue management as to what can and cannot be done. For example some ministers insist that no flash photography is allowed, and others will insist that the photographer shoot from a specific location. In such circumstances the bride and groom agree to accept the technical limitations that may be imposed on the equipment used. We advise the bride and groom to make themselves aware of the rules of the venue concerned and if necessary negotiate with the parties concerned. Where possible, this will be identified by *Adrian Jackson Photography* and communicated to the Bride and Groom prior to the wedding day. Similarly, *Adrian Jackson Photography* will provide advice and guidance on alternative options in the event of inclement weather in cases where outside images are unsuitable.

COPYRIGHT LAW: English Copyright Law states that the copyright of photographs remains with the photographer. Copyright ownership of your wedding photos is transferred to the bride and Groom upon full payment under the following conditions. The digital images taken by *Adrian Jackson Photography* are for personal use by the bride and groom and their friends and relatives. If selling the wedding photos for profit the bride and groom, their friends and relatives must obtain permission from *Adrian Jackson*. Where the Bride and Groom have opted to receive a CD/DVD containing images of their wedding day, a letter of authorisation shall be provided granting permission to print copies at high street printers.

MODEL RELEASE: The Bride and Groom grant *Adrian Jackson Photography* and its legal representatives, heirs and assigns, the irrevocable and unlimited consent to use the photographs of the bride and groom for editorial, competition, advertising and any other purpose and in any manner, to alter the photographs without restriction; and to copyright the images. The Bride and groom hereby releases *Adrian Jackson Photography* and its legal representatives, heirs and assigns from all liability and claims in connection with the images.

LIMIT OF LIABILITY: If the photographer is too ill or becomes injured and cannot supply the wedding services specified above, *Adrian Jackson Photography* will do everything possible to book a replacement wedding photographer. Liability is, however, limited to a refund of any payments received. **It is recommended that wedding insurance is taken out by the Bride and Groom to cover such circumstances.** *Adrian Jackson Photography* has working methods in place to prevent the loss or damage to your images (the digital images are backed up constantly to separate storage media throughout the wedding, duplicate equipment is on hand in case of breakage or failure). However, there exists the unlikely possibility that images may be lost, stolen or destroyed for reasons beyond the control of *Adrian Jackson Photography*. In these circumstances, liability is limited to the return of fees paid for the service or part thereof according to the percentage of original images supplied.

DEPOSIT: A minimum deposit of £100 shall secure the services of Adrian Jackson Photography on date identified on this agreement. Where a change of date is necessary, Adrian Jackson Photography cannot guarantee availability however every effort shall be made to accommodate the new date. Where it has not been possible to accommodate the change in date the deposit paid shall be refundable where notification is received up to 8 weeks (56 days) prior to the date of the wedding after which point the deposit shall be retained and considered as liquidated damages to Adrian Jackson Photography.

CANCELLATION TERMS: In the event that the bride and groom cancel the wedding, for whatever reason, the following timescales shall be adhered to:

Where notice of cancellation is received up to 8 weeks (56 days) prior to the wedding date, the booking deposit paid shall be non-refundable. Deposits paid shall be considered as liquidated damages to Adrian Jackson Photography.

Where notice of cancellation is received less than 8 weeks (56 days) but greater than 4 weeks (28 days) prior to the wedding date, 50% of the total amount agreed shall be payable and be considered as liquidated damages to Adrian Jackson Photography.

Where notice of cancellation is received less than 4 weeks (28 days) prior to the wedding date, the total amount agreed shall be payable and be considered as liquidated damages to Adrian Jackson Photography.

DELIVERY OF IMAGES: Photo are provided on a USB and are normally ready within 14 days of the wedding. Where printed albums have been selected, delivery time will be based upon that set by the printing supplier, Adrian Jackson Photography cannot be held responsible for delays where a third party is involved.
