RAW TO RESULT-R2R

Each week, on Monday evening, we will post the R2R images processed during the past week. You will find these in the "after" gallery except for images that have not been processed by three reviewers. Where an image has been processed by one or two reviewers the original image along with its "after" version(s) will stay in the "before" gallery until it has been reviewed by three people or until it has been in the "before" gallery for three weeks whichever comes sooner, at which point it will be moved to the "after" gallery. You will also see a document showing thumbnails of the before and after images side-by-side as well as the processing notes from the member(s) who edited them. We will add more images to the "before" gallery so there is always a good choice for you to have a go at. Because we want to keep the challenge alive, "Before" images will be removed after three weeks, or when

three people have chosen them to edit, whichever comes sooner. The “before” gallery will then be topped up from the image bank.

We would like to send the “after” images to the original author & the editors, as there are limitations to the quality and size we can display on website. If you edit an image and would prefer that we do not share it with the author, please let me know when you return your edited image.

So far, I have received images from only a few members for the gallery. I need more please. I will keep them in the image bank to add in future weeks.
