REQUIREMENTS FOR DIGITAL PROJECTED IMAGES COMPETITIONS

Entries for **Class 2 – DP Images** may consist of up to a total of 5 images from any one person.

DIGITAL IMAGES: -

Color Space: sRGB.

Standard jpeg file format

Resolution as original file (between 72 - 300 ppi)

Submit up to 5 images resized so as not to exceed 1024 pixels wide by 768 pixels high in landscape format. Portrait format must not exceed 768 pixels high.

Images to be named and numbered: - 01_short title, 02_short title etc.

Images to be in a folder with your name and put onto a CD-R marked with a permanent marker (no sticky labels), your name and the competition name or on a memory stick similarly identified.

Details to be recorded on an entry form with your name and image titles in 1 - 5 order.

NOTES: -

Before resizing any DIs make copies; this will safeguard your original files.

Open your image in Photoshop.

Click on "Image" / "Convert Color Profile" / "Convert to sRGB Profile".

Click on "Image" / "Resize" / "Image Size"

Make sure that you have checked (ticked) the "Constrain Proportions" and "Resample Image" boxes, then adjust as follows: -

Landscape Format

In the "Pixel Dimensions" box change width to 1024 Pixels. Now check the "Height" and if this exceeds 768 Pixels, change the height to 768 Pixels.

Portrait Format

In the "Pixel Dimensions" box, change "Height" to 768 Pixels.

Click "OK" then Click "File" / "Save As" – Change the file name to "01_Title" or "02_Second Title" as appropriate. (Don't include the quote marks and note the underscore between the number and the start of the title, but not elsewhere).

Change Format to Standard jpeg.

Click Save.

Create New Folder

Make a new folder with your name inserted - e.g. C:/joe bloggs

Copy your images to this folder so that you have C:/joe blogs/01_image one, etc., etc.

Format a new blank CD-R Disk or use a Memory Stick

Copy the folder complete with your 5 images onto the new disk or stick. Write your name on the disk as well as the competition name using only a permanent marker (no sticky labels) and hand the disk or stick to the Competition Secretary with your written list of entries.
