UB the Judge Evening

This is a fun event where you can submit up to four images, one for each of four rounds. Attending members on the night will vote on the best images in each round. The overall winner, will be the member with the highest number of votes at the end of the evening.

You can submit up to four images into this event. Tell the competition secretary which image should go into which round. It's up to you, put your best image forward in round one, or leave it until round four and hope to get lots of votes from the attending members.

This is an "Open" event, no "Set Subject". So put in an "Ah image" to get the votes, or an abstract, or a straight from the camera image, it's up to you. You're competing with the other submitted images in each round, so you won't know if you will get the votes until the end of the evening!

Image format, DPI only, jpg maximum quality, colour profile sRGB, size 1600 by 1200 pixels landscape, for portrait format maximum hight 1200 pixels. You don't need to add a canvas area around the image to get the correct size for our projector.

File name of the image for each round as follows:

- "1 Title Image -Mxx.jpg", "2 Title Image-Mxx.jpg", "3 Title Image-Mxx.jpg" and
- "4 Title Image-Mxx.jpg". Where Mxx is your club member's number Example:

Q&As

Can I vote for my own image?

No.

Is there any restriction on what images I can use?

Yes. No images should have been seen in any previous competition or fun event.

Can I use any of the images in any future club competition? Yes.

Who do I send my images to?

Email them to competition secretary.

When do you want the images?

The earlier the better, but all images must be with competition secretary at least one week before the event.

What happens if I don't send the image(s) in with the correct format? Competition secretary is available to assist with the process.

If I need help, who do I contact?

Competition secretary or any of the committee members.

Will I get a reminder about submitting images into this Fun Event Evening?

Yes - the Competition Secretary is very good at this!

Club Team Fun Event Evening

- Two teams, "Focus" and "Aperture".
- Members for each team have been selected randomly out of the hat.
- This is an "Open DPI club fun event", no set-subject.
- The image(s) should not have been used in any previous Barnstaple competition, including any fun night e.g., Digital KO/UB The Judge etc.
- Your image could be a straight from the camera shot, manipulated, creative in the camera or with software, or both!
- Submitted images can be used in any future club competition.
- The images will be critique and judged on Zoom, by Ann Owens CPAGB EFIAP, on the 4th January 2024.
- Scoring of each image will be out of 10 points.
- The team with the highest score is the winning team all good fun!

The following rules apply for each team:

- Total number of images from each group = 25 images.
- A maximum of 3 images from any one member.
- All members of the team should be encouraged to submit one image.
- A team co-ordinator will be selected for each team.
- Team images critique and selection on the club night of the 23rd November. Final hand-in date to the Competition Secretary - by the 22nd December, so plenty of time to modify, change, or add additional images into your team selection pot!

Q&As.

- What's the file name and format of the submitted images?
 - "Image Title-Mxx.jpg" e.g. The Tree House-M23.jpg. Image format, DPI only, jpg maximum quality, colour profile sRGB, size 1600 by 1200 pixels landscape, for portrait format maximum hight 1200 pixels. You don't need to add a canvas area around the image to get the correct size for our projector.
- What happens if a team member fails to present an image? No penalty scores with this fun event.
- What happens if the team submits less than the 25 total images? No penalty scores with this fun event.
- Who decides which members should provide additional (maximum three) images?
 Up to the team members.
- Who do I send my team image(s) to?
 By email to the Team co-ordinators.
- What happens if more members join the club?
 - Any new member joining the club will be allocated to one of the teams.
