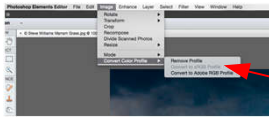
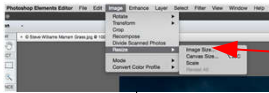


# Prepare Digital Image for Competitions – Photoshop Elements 13



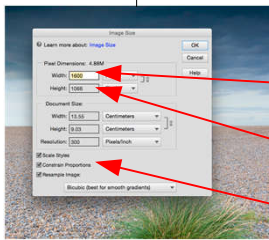
## 1) Set profile to sRGB

This menu item greys out when selected and means sRGB is set.



## 2) Set maximum image size

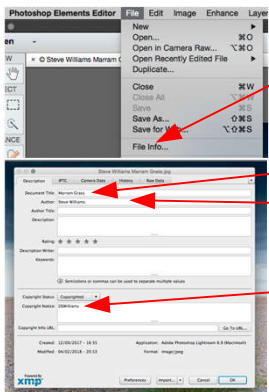
This menu item opens the following screen:



This must be a maximum of 1600.

This must be a maximum of 1200.

Before you change the width or height (above) make sure all of these are ticked as shown, with "Bicubic" selected



## 3) Set file info

This menu item opens the following screen.

Title of image in here.

Name of photographer in here

Fill in the copyright information if you wish.

## 4) Save to File

This menu item opens the following screen.

This show the "navigator" for a Mac computer.

The PC version is similar

Enter the filename as {name of photographer} {title}, using the same as you put into the file info (step 3 above).

*In this example the photographer is "Steve Williams" and the title is "Marram Grass"*

Navigate to the disk and directory you want to save the image file in

Make sure this is set to JPEG

Then press the Save button – the following screen opens

Set this to 12 (or whatever maximum value your version of Photoshop Elements has) – you can use the slider instead

Then press the OK button.

Your digital image is then saved to the file you have named above
