COVID-19 safety protocol – SUBJECT TO REVISION

Dancers are responsible for their own well-being at the Ceilidh and when travelling to and from the event. You must also consider the well-being of others.

Before attending, dancers should check the latest government guidance on Covid-19 at www.gov.uk/coronavirus.

You must stay away if you

- feel unwell with symptoms associated with Covid-19
- your last lateral flow or PCR test was positive
- are subject to a requirement to quarantine or isolate

We ask you to

- take a lateral flow test in the 24 hours before the Ceilidh
- leave if you feel at all unwell with symptoms associated with Covid-19
- notify us if you test positive within 3 days of attending
- keep up to date on any vaccinations offered
- bring your own hand sanitiser and use regularly between dances
- maintain social distancing when not dancing
- bring your own water/flask and refreshments

We will

- keep the hall ventilated
- notify attenders if a fellow dancer subsequently reports a positive test
- provide water to refill your bottle
- comply with any applicable Government Guidance on confirming
 - vaccination status
 - recent negative Covid-19 test
