PROJECTED DIGITAL IMAGES (PDIs).

First, prepare your digital images. (And PDIs of your Prints).

Maximum 1600 pixels wide by maximum 1200 pixels high
sRGB colour space (sRGB IEC6 1966-2.1)

Jpeg

Make a new folder and name it with YOUR NAME

Open this folder and make a sub folder for each PDI and Print section you are entering.

As an example:

John Smith

Open (or Novice) Colour PDI

Open (or Novice) Mono PDI

Open (or Novice) Nature PDI

Open (or Novice) Colour Prints

Open (or Novice) Mono Prints

Open (or Novice) Nature Prints

People prints

Set Subject (abc) PDI (one for each section)

Set Subject (abc) Prints (one for each section)

You should end up with 1 folder with just your name and the folder should contain a sub folder for each section you are entering (these sub folders will contain your entries). Please make sure that the title of your electronic file is the same as the titles on the entry form and that they are placed within the correct section sub-folder

Burn these folders to a CD or copy to a memory stick / memory pen or similar.

Hand in with your paper entry form. Please ensure the title on your paper entry form is the same as the title on your image.

We use a program called “Dicentra” to organize the digital competition. Dicentra will read your name and the titles of your images and produce paper copies of all entries. The organizers do not have to manually type this info, saving a lot of work ! So please enter your name and titles correctly. Many thanks.

EPPS Annual Competition

Please read and follow the rules for all entries to the Annual Competition as given on our website under “Competition Rules”.

-You do not have to enter the maximum number of images in each section.

-An image (or a significantly similar image) can only be entered once into the Annual Competition.

-If you use any watermark or other identifying logo on your images, this must be removed; such images cannot be entered into competitions.

-Only Novice members are allowed to enter the “Novice” sections. Novice members are recommended to enter these Novice sections and to avoid the “Open” sections (which are open to all members). However, Novice members may enter these “Open” sections if they so wish. In this case please note that a maximum of four images may be entered, shared between the Novice and Open sections.

In order to run any Novice section, we need to have entries from at least two novice workers in that section (Print or PDI). If we only have entries from a single novice worker in any section, those entries will be placed into the appropriate Open section instead.

- The four nature sections have special Nature rules. See our website for the Nature rules.

Special Notes (*regrettably, any entries that fail to meet these specifications cannot be used in the competition*):

The member named must have taken the images submitted, and have the full copyright of all elements of the image at their disposal. Manipulated images are welcome in this competition, provided the photographer has carried out all the manipulation, and that he/she took the original exposure(s). Images constructed from so-called 'royalty free' and 'copyright free' images to which nobody owns the copyright are not acceptable.

All print entries must be mounted on a sheet of mountboard that is exactly 50 cm x 40 cm in size, and the final product must be no more than 4 mm in thickness. The printed image itself may be any size up to that of the board.

PRINTS ENTRIES

Each print entered must also have an accompanying digital image file which adheres to the Society's rules for PDI competitions, i.e. it must be maximum 1600 pixels wide by maximum 1200 pixels high and must be saved in the sRGB colour space in JPEG format. It **must** have the same title as the print itself.

Prints should be marked on the **top LH side of the back** with:-

- 1) EPPS AC 2019
- 2) the Section entered e.g. Open Monochrome
- 3) the Title of the Print
- 4) Your Name
